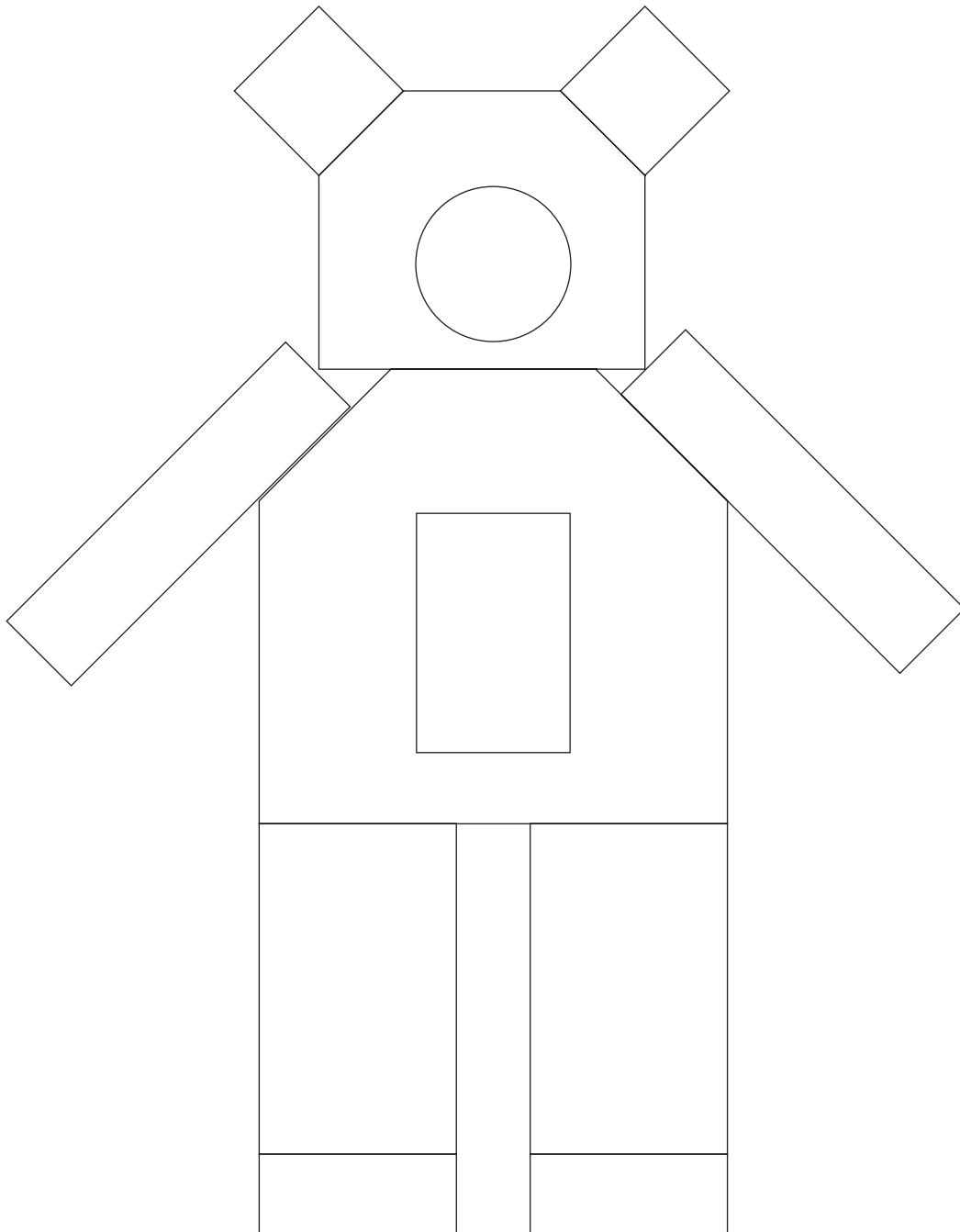


Template: "A Cake Takes Shape": Bear (assembly diagram)

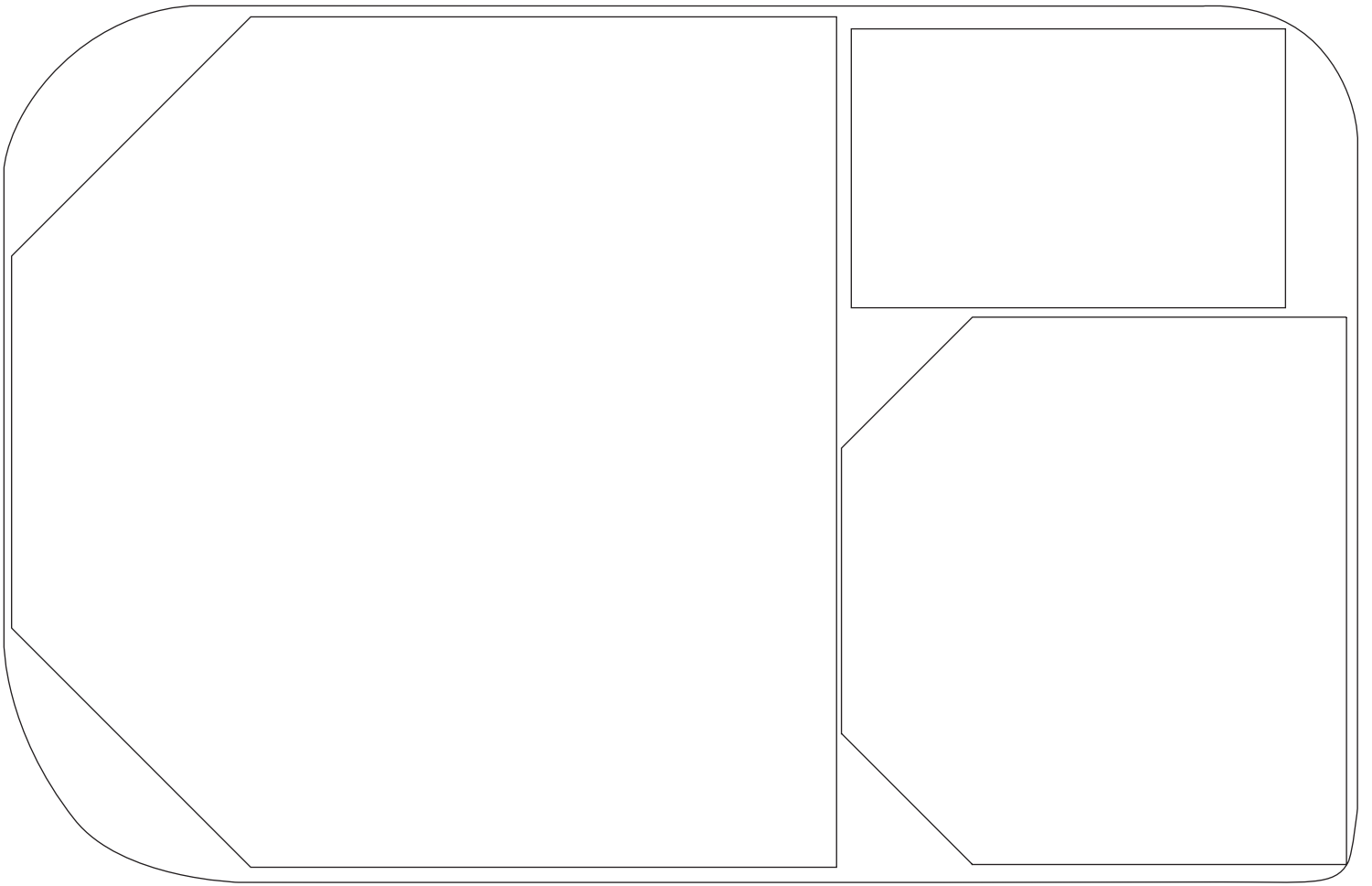

Use this page as a reference for the bear's assembly: Templates for the snout, head, body, belly, ears, arms, legs, and feet follow the cake diagrams. Print templates on card stock, and cut out. Arrange templates for body, belly, and head on one cake as demonstrated in cake diagram 1. Arrange templates for snout, ears, arms, legs, and feet on top of the other cake, as demonstrated in cake diagram 2. Trace around templates with a paring knife, cutting out the shapes. Halve snout and belly pieces horizontally. Assemble cake pieces as shown. Trim sharp edges from shoulders, ears, and front paws.



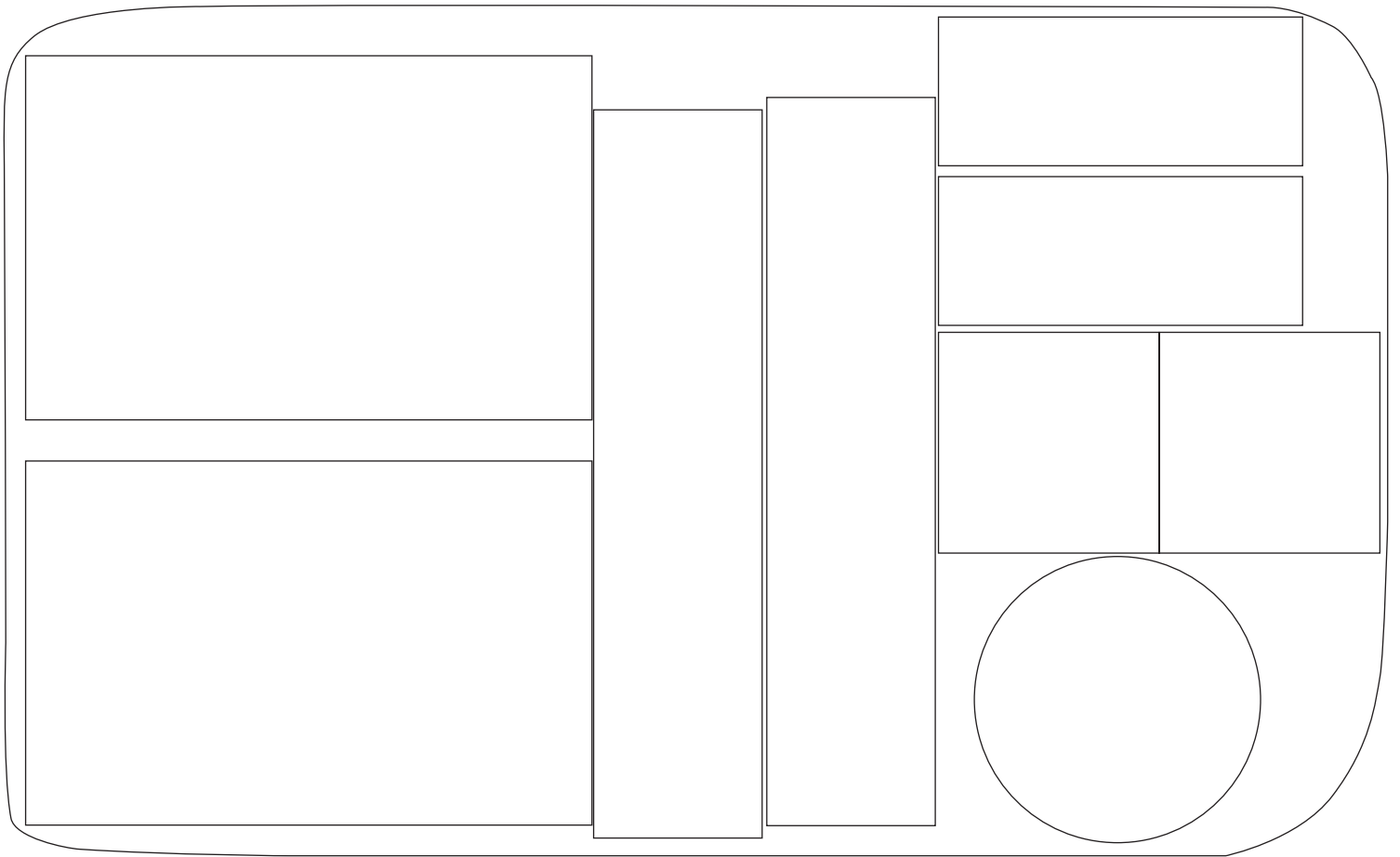
Template: "A Cake Takes Shape": Bear (cake diagram 1, with body, belly, and head)

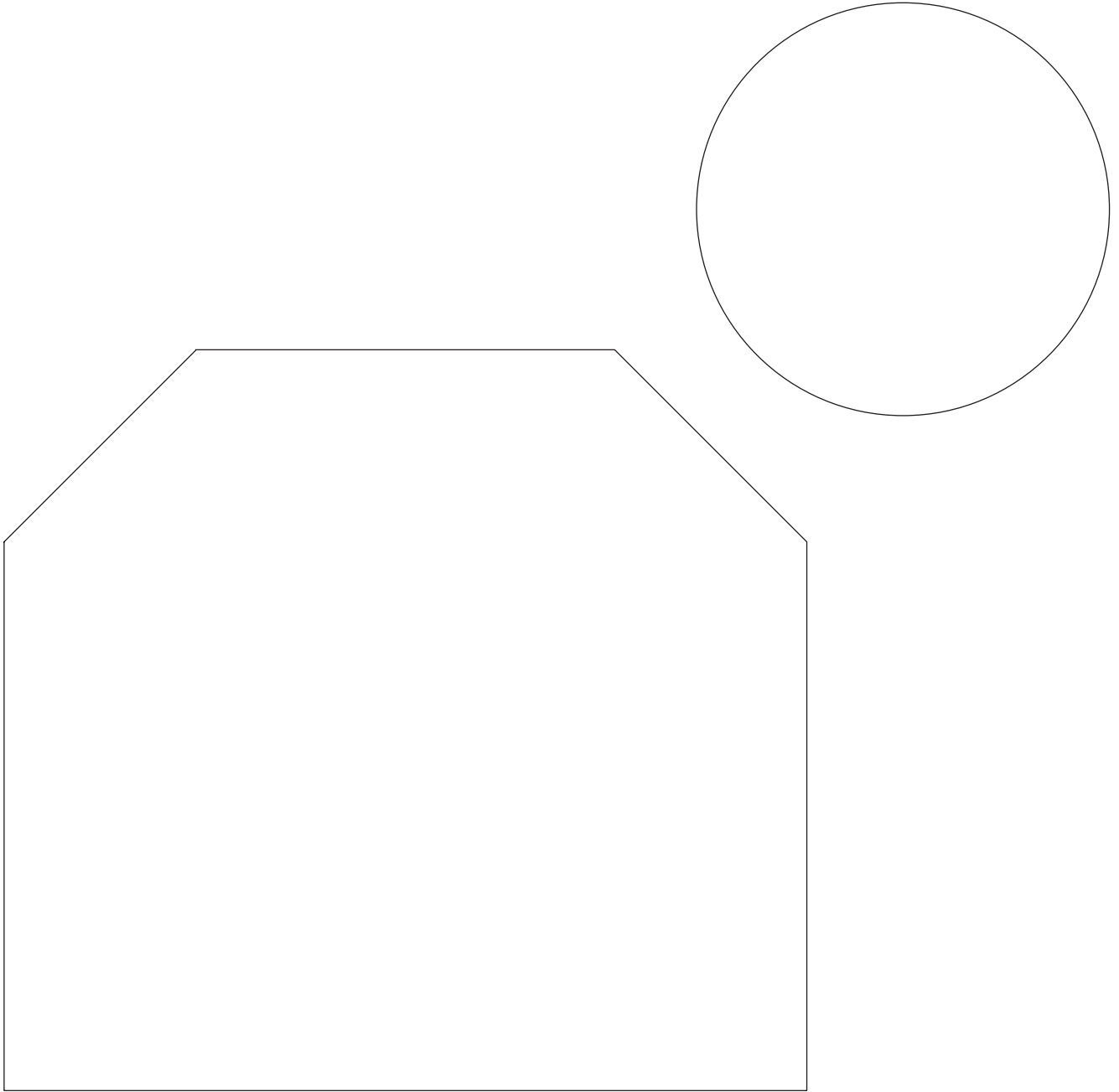
Template: "A Cake Takes Shape": Bear (cake diagram 2, with legs, arms, feet, ears, and snout)

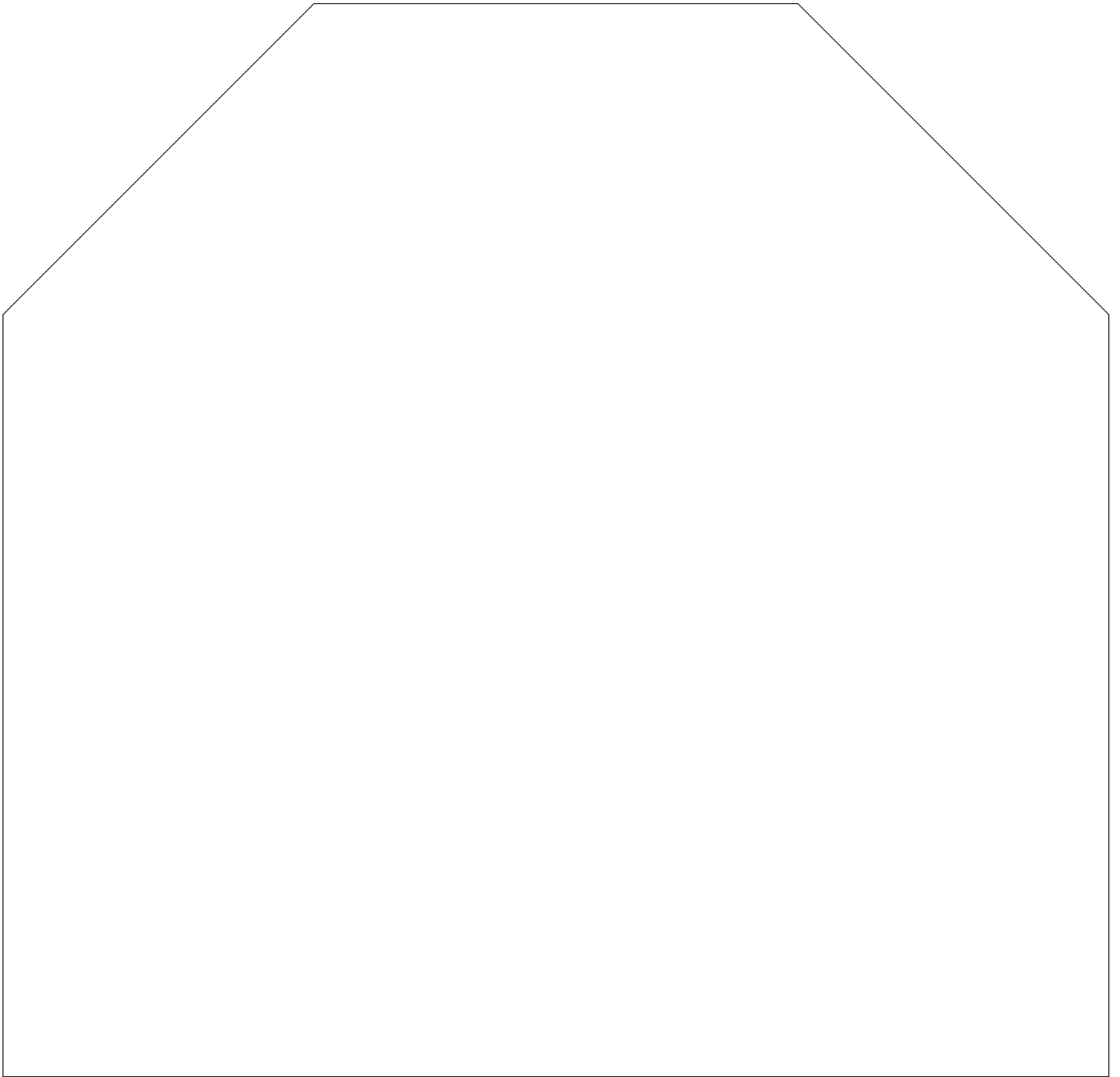
Template: "A Cake Takes Shape": Bear (snout and head)

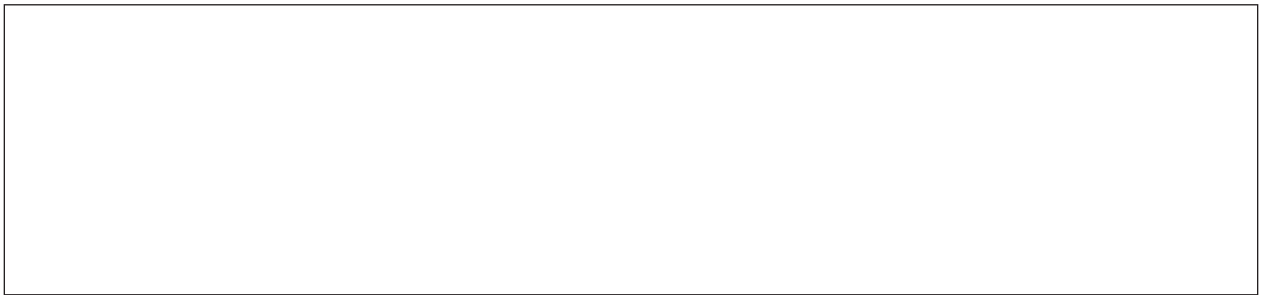
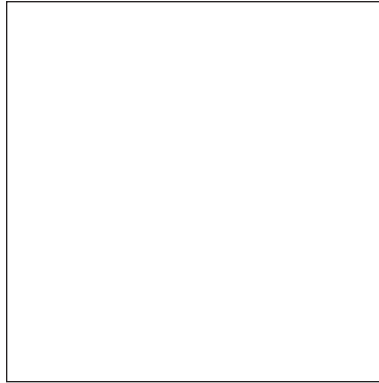
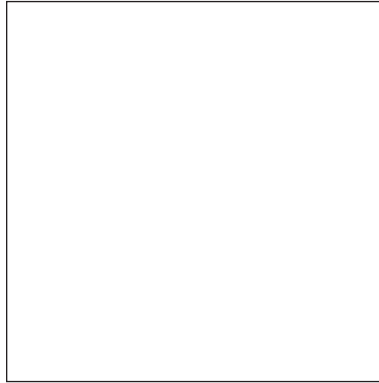
Template: "A Cake Takes Shape": Bear (body)
